 Must be able to utilize a personal vehicle within the Whitehorse city limits; extensive travel, up to 50% of the time, throughout the rest of the Yukon will be required (up to 1-3 weeks per trip) but using a government-issued fleet vehicle; ability to lift up to 50 lbs; and must be comfortable working with young children (preschool and school-age) and working alone
